Using Your OSHC

OSHC pays for part or all of the costs related to:

- •Doctor Visits (GP): If you need to see a general practitioner.
- •Hospital Treatments: Coverage for hospital stays and procedures.
- •Ambulance Services: In case of emergencies.
- •Pharmacy Medicines: Some medications are covered
- •OSHC basic OSHC does not cover dental, optical or physiotherapy treatments.
- •You may need to pay a medical bill after receiving treatment, then you can claim it back through your OSHC provider using their online portal.



Visa Obligations

- Study 20 hours per week
- Attend Classes
- Meet all course requirements
- Remain enrolled in a registered education program
- Paid work up to 24 hours per week (48 hrs/fortnight)
- Maintain adequate health insurance
- Don't overstay your visa period in Australia
- Notify your training provider if you change your address
